We are "lucky" to have such a wonderful school with support from families and staff. As you may have heard, we have two teachers out on leave for medical reasons. In the absence, we welcomed Ms. Marjorie to help in the reading position for grades 1 and 2. In PE, I will take the students one hour a week until Coach can return. So far, we focused on "team building" and sportsmanship with our first lesson. Next, we moved to our Child Safety Matters (Monica Burr Foundation) on keeping safe at home and school. Beginning March 11th (March 4th for Room 8) we will focus on the whole body with Yoga and stretching with an emphasis on personal self—control and individual strength. On the other days, the classroom teachers will deliver Health and Wellness lessons and supervised outdoor play. Together, we will take care of our students and their needs.


