As we move into fall, we look forward to cooler weather bringing relief from the heat and humidity. **October** is a month of important awareness campaigns, and we want to take a moment to highlight two that touch many families across the country—and even here in our own school community.

- **Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) Awareness**

First recognized nationally in 1988 by President Ronald Reagan, this campaign raises awareness of ASD, a neurodevelopmental disorder that affects communication, social interaction, and repetitive behaviors. Today, it is estimated that more than 3 million children in the United States are affected.

- **Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) Awareness**

ADHD is a neurodevelopmental disorder characterized by persistent patterns of inattention and/or hyperactivity-impulsivity that interferes with functioning or development in multiple areas of life. ADHD Awareness Month was established to dispel myths and promote understanding, ADHD Awareness Month brings attention to a condition that impacts an estimated 7.1 million children ages 3–17 in the United States.

We will also be observing **Red Ribbon Week** this **October 27th-31st**.

Red Ribbon Week highlights the importance of making good choices, and this will be the message we will continue to reinforce through the classroom activities that week. Our goal is to guide students toward decisions that will positively shape their futures.

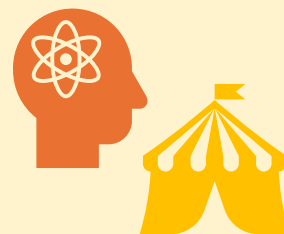

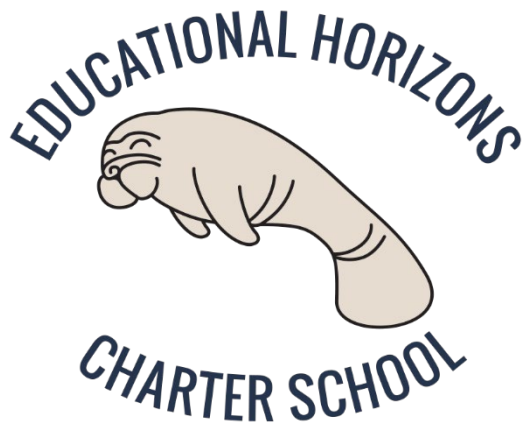
